- Drawdown update (George)
  - City pending projects.
    - Trees being trimmed along shorelines on Elm Creek (north).
    - Debris being gathered and collected in creek (and later lake).
    - Stumps only to be removed if navigation hazard and on public property.
- Shoreline Erosion Assessment project follow up (George)
  - Impact on residents.
    - 9 private homeowner properties considered High/Medium priority.
    - Communication sent out to all residents & City & TRPD on February 15.
  - Feedback? Pending actions?
    - No feedback yet from residents or City.

- Several residents on Elm Creek (Tristan Bay) seeking corrective action with riprap installations this winter before drawdown concludes.
- **Fish Restocking update** (George)
  - Discuss latest action and next steps
    - Sub Committee has met one to hear U of Minnesota expert on Carp habits discuss best methods for eliminating and controlling them.
    - Sub Committee interviewing local fisheries for pricing on game fish to restock this spring, including: Largemouth Bass, Sunfish, & Crappies.
- Winter Aerator (George)
  - Consider alternate storage assuming City will not house equipment.
    - Wait until later this summary for next steps to test and store equipment.
  - Find an electrician to help test/repair motor for use next winter.
    - George to check with local electrician who serviced Tristan Bay fountain aerator in the past.

  - 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday in May (May 5)
    - Discuss venue
