## RLAA Board Meeting Minutes for September 21, 2015

- Call to Order at 7:10 pm
  - o Present
    - George, Rick, Jeremy, Luke, Mike (joined later)
  - Absent
    - Scott, Bill, Mark
- Approve the Agenda
- Treasurer Report (Rick)
  - o \$15,891 in Checking
  - \$3,052 in Savings
  - o Expecting another \$5,000 in City reimbursement for Fish Stocking later this year
  - o Total dues collected around \$6,000
- New Business
  - 2015-2016 Winter Aeration update
    - Current Status
      - Float/Tube and remaining motor at George's house waiting testing by electrician.
      - Cable, PVC protective pipes and signs remain at City storage on Fernbrook Lane, but can be pulled out when we are ready for them.
      - Aeration application submitted to DNR (I/P)
      - Order more Thin Ice and Warning decals for more signs (I/P)
    - Next Steps
      - Contact Xcel Energy to activate power to meter (George)
      - Test the aerator motor/float (George with electrician)
      - Follow up with DNR on submitted Aeration application (George)
      - Clear out brush around power box to insure accessible (All)
      - Build more Thin Ice/Warning signs using ordered decals from DNR (All)
      - Deploy aerator cable w/marker buoy in the lake 350' from shoreline
        - Sometime prior to 10/10, several of us go with Jeremy with his truck/trailer to get the aerator cable/drum out of storage. Also take the remaining items at the storage facility (PVC, anchors and signs)
        - 10/10 Jeremy (and Luke?) drive over by truck/trailer to deliver the aerator cable, PVC, anchors and signs to the power meter location for deployment
        - 10/10 Rest of crew arrives by pontoon to meet up with Jeremy/Luke to put out the cable and buoy marker in the lake.
        - Ice In Cable connected to power meter and crew enters by ice to replace marker buoy with aerator.
          - Cut hole in ice with chain saw.
          - Install Thin Ice signs around the expected open water area and tie off with rope (for easier withdrawl in spring)
          - Turn on aerator and let it run 24x7.
  - Weaver Lake Road exit ramp work (Luke/Jeremy)
    - Sound barrier wall request how to pursue?
      - Luke reached out to Dennis Smith (MN House) for help.
      - Jeremy has reached out to the EPA (Washington, DC) waiting for response
- Other Business
  - Channel Dredging update Legal steps and how to finance (All)
    - Due to normal or higher than normal water level this season, we did not seem to encounter issues with channel access. Any ideas on how to handle the future?

- Nothing for now, but revisit next year if this proves to be an issue.
- Fish stocking update (George)
  - 3 of the 4 stockings have been completed. Final one set for September or October for 3-4" largemouth bass
    - Question in to Wade Quale when the fisherman will do the last installation.
    - We will submit reimbursement to the City for \$5,000 of the \$7,500 total after the last installation has been completed.
- Membership Committee status (George)
  - No responses to the previous committee members to Dave Wirig (see e-mail)
    - Consensus Need to get the word out that RLAA exists and is there to benefit the residents. Facebook may be the best alternative.
      - Jeremy offered to have his wife set up a Facebook page to start doing some posting.
      - o George forwarded the contact info of Dave Wirig to Jeremy to collaborate.
      - o Mike said he can also have his wife help come up with some posting ideas.
- o **2015 Lake Improvement Project (LIP) review** (George)
  - Shoreline Assessment reimbursement received late July 2015 for \$2,200.
  - Fish Restocking reimbursement request for \$5,000 will be submitted after last fish stocking this fall.
