- Call to Order at 7:10 pm
 - Present: Mark, George, Rick, Mike, Scott
 - o Absent: Curt, Luke, Jeremy
- Approve the Agenda
- Treasurer Report (Mike)
 - \$24,742.33 in Savings & Checking accounts
 - o 2019 Financials updated for next month's annual meeting
 - o Suggest adding the new Aerator to 2019 Projects list in the Annual Meeting presentation
- Old Business
 - Boat Ramp access (Scott)
 - Before we commit to a dredging project, need to secure access to the boat ramp
 - Subcommittee (Scott, George, Dave Wirig) working on this with local attorney
 - Dredging update (Scott)
 - Dependent on Boat Ramp future access
 - Lowest bid to date is TDT for \$15,000. May discount if include Gross rip-rap.
 - City has indicated they will NOT contribute something.
 - Boaters Fund to off-set rip-rap and dredging cost isn't looking too good, since we don't even have many of the boaters even paying dues yet.
 - Possible Alternate Boat Ramp site
 - This would be part of our Boat Ramp access initiative
 - Temporary access may be necessary for Carp Removal project (written into the contract)
 - No action at this time. Would need to be on private property for permanent use, since City would only support it if used for Public Access.
 - For possible Carp Removal project, would need to find temporary access for commercial fisherman. Maybe southernmost Glacier Lane cul-de-sac?
 - RLAA Insurance coverage should we pursue? (Jeremy/George)
 - Cedar Island is the only MG lake which I found that has coverage.
 - Should we pursue getting our own policy? Do we want D & O coverage? This may be even more necessary if we have more of an investment in the boat ramp.
 - Jeremy has received a bid for \$600 for \$1,000,000 coverage, including D&O. Let's vote on this later via e-mail.

 - Carp Assessment (George)
 - Tracking & Removal Phase II
 - Supported by City, TRPD, ECWMC and FLARA with funding assistance
 - Radio Tracking device to be purchased in 2019 by RLAA (\$1,000)
 - Winter Aerator upgrade (George)
 - Approval for funding from City (LQC) for below surface diffuser model (\$3,000 of \$7,000)
 - Subcommittee (George, Jeremy, Dave Wirig) working on coordinating this for 2019
- New Business
 - 2019 Annual Meeting prep (George)
 - Scheduled for Tuesday, May 7th at Cambria Suites
 - Stick with same PPT format as in the past.
 - Guest Speakers include WSB (Carp) and Eric Swenson (10000 Docks)
